I. **CALL TO ORDER**

III. **SCBOA MINUTES (MARCH 2022 MEETING)**

The SCBOA Minutes from March 2022 were distributed. Motion made by James Williams to accept the minutes as information. Second by Jerome Hall.

IV. **ASSOCIATE COMMISSIONERS REPORT**

The SCBOA payments and balance were shared with the Directors by the Associate Director, Charlie Wentzky.

- Registration will open August 1, 2022 - October 15th, 2022.
- Last day to register without late fees will be October 15th, 2022.
- If a **new official** registers late; contact Jan Hogan about reimbursement of late fees
- Online Test will be available September 1, 2022 – November 4, 2022.
- Directors that will be officiating will pay the full \$75.00 registration fee. Directors will not be charged for an Arbiter sub-account (\$35.00).
- Each District should have one additional person familiar with your District's Arbiter account.
- New rules: Securing beads and braids
 - Language: "Secure them or they cannot play in this contest"



- 35 second shot clocks will be allowed for invitationals, tournaments and showcases. Shot clocks **will NOT** be allowed for regular or playoff games.
- Game fees increase:
 - \$63.00 for a single varsity game.
 - \$105.00 for 2 varsity games (back-to-back)
 - \$40.00 per game for sub-varsity.
 - Mileage minimum is \$11.00 (20 miles)
 - Any additional mileage will now be .55 cents a mile.
- We will have SCHSL In-Person Clinic this year. All clinics will start at 6:00 pm. Voice overs will be provided to Directors
